### **Gaza Sky Geeks Launches *GSG Talent Bridge* to Connect Palestinian Talent with the Gulf**

Doha, Qatar – 4 February 2026: Gaza Sky Geeks (GSG), a Mercy Corps program in Palestine, is participating in Web Summit 2026 in Qatar to expand market access for Palestinian talent and launch **GSG Talent Bridge**, a new initiative designed to connect Palestinian youth and tech companies with mentorship, business support, and remote work opportunities across the Gulf.

At Web Summit Qatar, GSG is engaging with regional and global partners to build practical pathways that link Palestinian professionals to GCC-based mentors, advisors, and employers. The initiative responds to growing interest from the Gulf in meaningful, action-oriented ways to support Palestinian talent.

GSG Talent Bridge is a simple, online platform built around two core tracks:

- **Mentorship and Business Advisory:** A call for GCC-based mentors and experts to support Palestinian youth in strengthening technical and employability skills, and to advise Palestinian tech companies on business strategy, growth, and scaling.
- **Remote Internships and Hiring:** A call for GCC-based companies to host Palestinian talent remotely through internships or offer remote employment opportunities for Palestinian professionals.

#### **GSG Senior Manager, Rand Safi, said:**

“With the current situation in Palestine, the technology sector remains one of the most viable pathways for recovery and growth. Palestinian talent is vibrant, skilled, and ready. What is needed now is access, partnership, and stronger bridges to regional and global markets.”

Through its participation at Web Summit Qatar, GSG aims to build partnerships that translate into concrete outcomes — mentorship, contracts, jobs, and long-term collaboration — for Palestinian youth and tech companies.
